Decorate your chosen number thinking about:

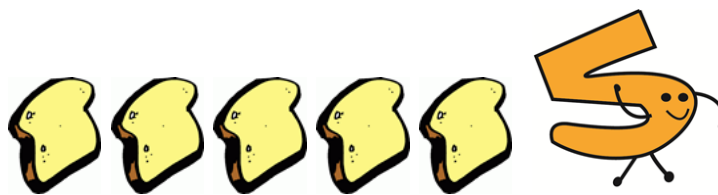
- ❖ How it represents itself?
